EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Tridant — Supply Chain Planning & Technology Consultant (Option 2)

Tridant's December 2025 Synchron VAR partnership and stated supply chain practice expansion describe the seam I have spent a career working in — operating-business supply chain depth meeting planning-platform configuration. The Option 2 pathway is mine almost word-for-word.

Two builds that anchor the case

Pacific Brands Workwear Group. Designed and built a centralised VBA planning engine harvesting six divisional ERPs, generating supplier orders, and producing branded supply and S&OP decks for divisional CEOs with mandatory sign-off governance. Multi-site team across VIC, NSW and NZ. In year one of operation the build delivered a 20% finished-goods stock reduction worth \$15M for the NNT division alone.

Saputo Dairy Australia. Built and deployed planning systems across retail and bulk ingredients divisions over an 8-year tenure. Retail cheese portfolio (Devondale, Coon, Cheer) including the Coon-to-Cheer national rebrand transition. Bulk ingredients: daily order-and-invoice projection system feeding finance, sales and operations; a Smartsheet-based centralised demand change portal capturing verification, approval, reporting and audit trail for every demand change request. Same spreadsheet-retirement problem Tridant's supply chain offering sets out to solve at platform scale.

Stack fit

Power BI, DAX, Power Query / M, Azure, Fabric — native ground. SAP ECC source side at scale. Microsoft Dynamics AX from prior role at Australian Defence Apparel. Smartsheet workflow / portal design (the Saputo demand change portal). Planning fundamentals are universal — every platform expresses the same problem space with different syntax — so new systems get adopted quickly.

Practical flags

Warrnambool-based; full-remote since 2019 — the role's confirmed AU / NZ / Singapore scope fits cleanly. Planned and infrequent client travel welcome. No completed bachelor's degree — career brings the practical experience the requirement is testing for. Happy to discuss either directly.
